- 1 cover-wraparound for perfect binder on 10pt C1S
- 152 sheets on 50# offset
- Text is furnished as folded signatures (1-16pp, 9-32pp)
- Maximum head, foot and face trim is 1-9/16", minimum is 1/8"
- Folded sigs must have closed spine (no z-folds)
- Cover stock should have grain running parallel to spine to help prevent cracking
- Covers furnished on press sheets for us to trim
- Covers are laid out for a perfect bound book allowing an 1/8" overhang from raw sig size on the head and foot
- Sigs are furnished skid packed or in skid tubs
- UV and varnish coating knocked out of spine/side glue area of inside cover, and side glue area of first and last pages

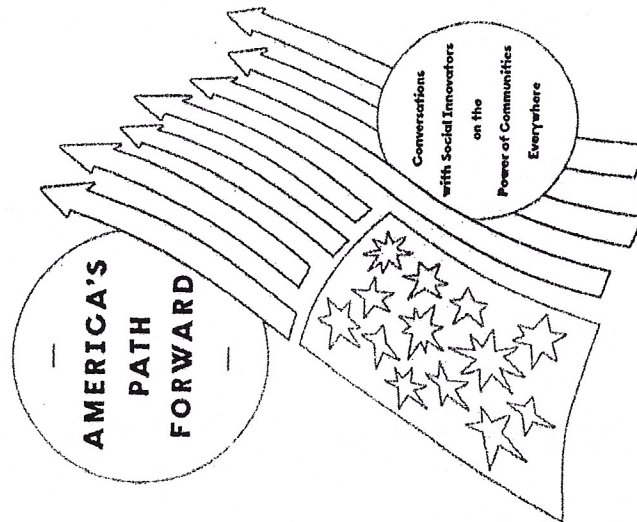
